Dear Friends in Christ,

The most common question I am asked is what translation of the Bible should I buy. (I lean toward the New Revised Standard Version.) The second most common question I am asked is how do Lutherans compare to _____? Maybe a child is marrying someone from another faith tradition. Maybe someone has moved to a place where there is no nearby LCMC congregation.

Our Sunday morning Bible class is finishing up an 18-month-long study of the Gospel of John. In January I would like to begin an 8-week study conversation on how Lutherans compare to other faith traditions. What are the points of agreement and disagreement? The series will cover what it means to be Lutheran, Roman Catholic, Episcopal, Presbyterian and Reformed, Methodist and Holiness, Baptist, Restorationist, Pentecostal, and a few others.



NOVEMBER COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

The Immanuel Council met November 12 with 10 of 13 members present. Craig Olson led devotion from a book by C.S. Lewis.

Treasurer: October income was \$19,920 and expenses were \$21,313 leaving a deficit of \$1,392 for the month and \$5,883 for the year. General Fund is at \$86,319 and Capital Reserve is at \$77,397.

Worship/Evangelism: We are going to look for an architectural consultant who can redesign the lighting and space in the front of the sanctuary.

Fellowship/Education: LYO high school group has grown and we are now feeding them each week. We need to see an increase in our youth fellowship budget. Spark Story Bibles have been purchased for children to use during worship.

Stewardship/Outreach: November Mission Partners are West Central Community Action and Shelby County Community Outreach.

Executive: Annual Congregational meeting was scheduled for January 19, 2025. Discussed employee reviews and increases in salaries and hours. Annual financial review will be scheduled.



DECEMBER COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

The Immanuel Council met December 10 with 12 of 13 members present. Dave Greve led devotions with a testimony about God's voice calling us to not give up. January devotions will be led by John Taggs. Eric, Rich and Barb, Joey, Vicki, John, Craig, Scott, Todd, Dave, and Trent volunteered for deacon duties.

Treasurer: November income was \$19,443 and expenses were \$23,306 leaving a monthly deficit of \$3,863 and a YTD deficit of \$9,747. General Fund is at \$82,810.75 and Capital Reserve is at \$78,397.86.

Outreach/Stewardship: December mission grants are Lutheran Bible Translators, LC Clinic, and Open Door Mission for \$1000 each.

Property: Furnace motor was fixed.

Executive: Ballot from the Nominating Committee was approved. For Council – Vicki Strissel, Scott Shannon, Ken Nielsen, and Kirk Jacobsen. For Trust Committee – Dave Voge. For 2025 Nominating Committee – Darin Haake, Lonnie Pitts, Mitch Petersen. 2025 Budget of \$288,491 was approved.

Pastor: Jared Walters needs to have an internship with a church as part of his B.A. in ministry at Institute of Lutheran Theology Christ College.

Old Business: Council had a review of the AED.

Correspondence: Thank you for donations of \$500 from Shelby County ISU extension for letting them use our building around fair time.



TANZANIA HAPPENINGS

Immanuel currently is in the midst of working on well #12 in Tanzania. The soil testing and the well drilling has been completed. We are thankful that they hit lots of quality water. We are now receiving the bids for the water tower and the solar pump and connections, although this part normally takes some time. The TZ committee received personal donations over the last several months to push us over the \$14,000 mark. So, we called Wallace the Pastor that manages the well drilling on that end and the well was drilled within the week! This well is a bit unique because it services two schools, one secondary school and one primary school besides the villagers around Masilu preaching point of Kidugala. There are more than 800 students in those two schools. When we told Wallace about the desire to drill well #12, he jumped right on it. The students at these two schools are currently getting their drinking water out of the river and this is the time of the year when the river water quality is the worst. Thank you, Immanuel, for supporting good drinking water in the Kidugala area of Tanzania.

The annual **TZ Soup Supper and Auction** is coming up sooner than we think. Please save the date of **March 15, 2025**, for a great time at the supper/ auction! Hope to see you there.

The TZ committee hasn't heard back from Kidugala on the exact dates that ambassadors will be visiting to help celebrate the 20th year of our partnership in Christ. We gave them a range of dates to pick from so stay tuned for this late summer event.
