#### IMMANUEL'S INSIGHTS



November 2024

Dear Friends in Christ,

Four of us from Immanuel joined over 600 people at the 2024 LCMC Gathering in Marion, Iowa. The official theme was "Engaging Your Cultural Moment." However, the Holy Spirit's agenda seemed to be focused on "Leading Through Our Weakness."

Pastor Kyle Fever spoke about his experience of a family crisis. He went from being the pastor with the answers to being a hurting pastor who struggled to believe. Weakness doesn't disqualify us. It frees us from illusions of control. It opens the door to the power of God. What weakness are we running from?

Pastor Stephen Witmer spoke about the gift of weakness. He noted how counter-cultural the apostle Paul was in talking about his own weakness. Every congregation has weaknesses. Small congregations can't hide theirs as well as large ones. God doesn't need our strength. God has plenty of power. But God needs our weakness to meet the weaknesses of the world. Will you yield your weakness to God? We need God's power to change hearts, but that power is only available to those who lean into their own weakness.

One of my favorite things about LCMC gatherings is hearing from young LCMC pastors. Our Bible Study leader was another outstanding young pastor named Gabrielle Arland. She spoke about Paul's ministry of weakness in I and 2 Corinthians and in Acts 17. We also heard from Pastor Renee Behrends whose congregation in Spencer, Iowa was devasted by flooding. But God is working through our weakness.

LCMC is now 1001 congregations in 16 countries. We heard several folks talk about their search for good pastors. There is no shortage of pastors in the larger cities, but there is a real shortage in rural and small-town areas. One Nebraska congregation has waited 2 years for a pastor and they now have 2 candidates. One is 74 and the other is 81 years old.

LCMC has 5 goals for the next few years: 1.) Developing Districts and Fellowships to help congregations and leaders connect with one another; 2. ) Developing and caring for congregational leaders; 3.) Strengthening us in our theological distinctives; 4. ) Welcoming and supporting congregations; and 5. ) Growing our generosity.

Speaking of generosity, LCMC has several special funds including a Church Planting Fund and a Lutheran Disaster Assistance (LDA) Fund. Over the past few years, over \$1 million has been given to the LDA Fund.

One of the highlights of the convention was a hymn-sing in a packed sanctuary singing with 600 powerful voices. The 2025 LCMC gathering will be back at Hosanna Lutheran Church in Lakeville, MN, October 5 to 8. Anyone is welcome to join us.

**Treasurer's Report**: October \$19,569 and expenses were \$21,331 leaving us with a net loss for 2024 of \$4,490. General Fund is at \$88,308 and Capital Reserve is at \$76,397.

**Worship/Evangelism Report:** The Mission Sunday with Pastor Jordan Long and the South Sudanese Choir was outstanding.

**Fellowship/Education Report:** Way too much good food at the Fall Fellowship Potluck Dinner. We have purchased new story Bibles for children to use while at Church. Planning on a Pie Potluck after the Thanksgiving Eve service.

**Stewardship/Outreach Report**: October Mission Partners are West Central Community Action and Shelby County Community Outreach. We will invite the congregation to give toward disaster relief in the Spencer, Iowa floods and the Southeast hurricanes. We will also invite people to participate in Operation Christmas Child.

**Property Report:** Urinal in the men's restroom has been repaired. Sewer line cleanout was only partially successful. We will probably have to replace the sewer line. Security cameras have been installed. Wifi access points have been installed. Carpet cleaning is scheduled.

**Executive Report:** We will conduct employee reviews this month.

**Pastor's Report:** Pastor reported on the LCMC Annual Gathering. He also recommended Stephen Lewo for membership at Immanuel.


# **ILCW NEWS**


