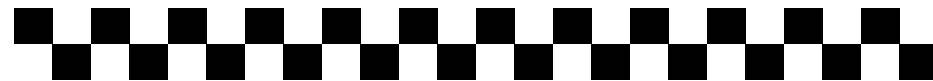

White grape juice is available in the center of the trays as an alternative to wine.
