WE CELEBRATE COMMUNION today. All baptized followers of Jesus who have received preparation for Communion are invited to participate. Communion is a sacrament, a gift of the Gospel for the renewal and strengthening of faith. A person is well prepared and worthy to receive Communion who believes the words, "given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sin" because the words, "for you" require simply a believing heart. White grape juice is available in the center of the trays as an alternative to wine.

PRAYER WALK A community prayer walk will be held Saturday, September 7 from 8:00 to 10:00 A.M. Starting from the front doors of the Middle School, prayer walkers will be invited to walk around the Middle School and High School praying for protection and blessing upon the teachers and students of our schools.
