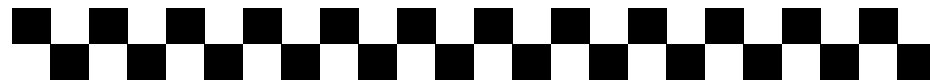

WELCOME! We are glad you are here today. Thank you for joining us in worship. You are welcome to join us for donuts, coffee and juice in the fellowship hall after worship.

CAMPS: Any member of ILC who will be attending either Riverside or Ingham-Okoboji camps is eligible for financial assistance from WOW/ILCW and from ILC. Applications are available in the church office for \$300 per child for individual campers or up to \$600 for a family with two or more children. Applications are due June 1, 2022 and money will be paid directly to the camp.

WELLS!!! The construction of wells in Tanzania has been a great opportunity for our congregation to contribute to our ongoing mission. With that in mind, members of our congregation have been lead to generously contribute to the well project.
