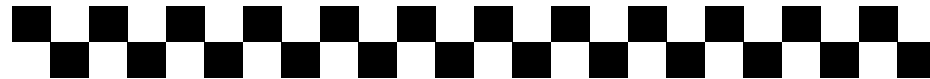

CALL THE CHURCH OFFICE to notify us if someone is ill, having surgery, requires a pastoral visit. The hospitals do not call us. You may leave a message on the answering machine after hours.

WE CELEBRATE COMMUNION today. All baptized followers of Jesus who have received preparation for Communion are invited to participate. We believe that Communion is the reception of “the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ given with bread and wine instituted by Christ himself for us to eat and drink.” Communion is a sacrament, a gift of the Gospel for the renewal and strengthening of faith. A person is well prepared and worthy to receive Communion who believes the words, “given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sin” because the words, “for you” require simply a believing heart.

AT COMMUNION, you will be invited to a station at the altar rail. Please bring your belongings with you. Each communing person may remove one white card which will uncover 2 cups. One cup holds the bread and the other holds wine. Please wait to take the cups until instructed. Grape juice is available under the cards so marked. After the blessing, you may leave the card on the altar rail and take the cups to the basket as you exit by the door to your left.

WELCOME! Thank you for joining us in worship. Today marks the beginning of the new year of worship in the Church. The 4 weeks of Advent prepare us to celebrate the gift of Christmas.

PANDEMIC PROCEDURES. We ask all worshipers to continue to observe physical distancing from other worshipers in the building. Please do not sit with anyone who did not come to worship with you. You are invited to take a mask and keep it as our gift to you.

WORSHIP SERVICES at Immanuel are recorded for viewing on HMU channel 15 (9:00 a.m. Sunday and 6:00 p.m. Sunday, Monday, and Wednesday) and on FMCTC channel 48 (4:00 p.m. Wednesday).
