WE CELEBRATE COMMUNION today. All baptized followers of Jesus who have received preparation for Communion are invited to participate. We believe that Communion is the reception of "the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ given with bread and wine instituted by Christ himself for us to eat and drink." Communion is a sacrament, a gift of the Gospel for the renewal and strengthening of faith. A person is well prepared and worthy to receive Communion who believes the words, "given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sin" because the words, "for you" require simply a believing heart.

AT COMMUNION, you will be invited to a station at the altar rail. Please bring your belongings with you. Each communing person may remove one white card which will uncover 2 cups. One cup holds the bread and the other holds wine. Please wait to take the cups until instructed. Grape juice is available under the cards so marked. After the blessing, you may leave the card on the altar rail and take the cups to the basket as you exit by the door to your left.
