At our 2022 annual congregational meeting, a clear majority of our members expressed a desire that we take steps to provide quality organ music for the future of our worship life. The Worship Committee has identified 2 options for moving forward. The original builder of our pipe organ, Temple, can do a full rebuild. Or we can purchase a new digital organ to replace our pipe organ.

If you have thoughts about a decision between a rebuilt pipe organ vs. a replacement with a digital organ and would be willing to share them with the church council, there is an information sheet and an opinion survey in the church office. You are welcome to take one, fill it out, and return it to the church office.
